- Have been recently made redundant or are between roles
- Are experiencing financial pressure that limits access to development
- Work in environments where professional development is not supported
- Are committed to continuing their growth despite these challenges

- A genuine need for support at this time
- A clear desire to grow and develop their capability
- Readiness to apply what they learn
- Commitment to completing the certification
